The recording begins with singing and drumming.

Around 3:00 man's voice is talking about how they need a score keeper for the archery contest. The price for the winner is \$20 dollars. The next event is men's wrestling contest, followed by women's archery contest. The speaker suggests that men and women's archery should be combined. They also have a boat race and 18-25 class and 30-50 class [probably age groups]. The price for motor boat races is winner takes it all. At 4pm there is going to be women's arm wrestling which should be fun because some of the ladies have very strong arms.

At 4:37 the announcer says that they have a canoe contest going on. The route is across the river and back and the guys will be back shortly. Mike Klein and Babe Keller are their time keepers.
