13:10 Edna Stickman [?] sings a song. [Indistinct talking.]

16:59 Edna Stickman sings another song, other people join in. [Talking and laughing.]

19:56 Crispin Stickman starts singing a short song. [Applause, indistinct talking.]

20:41 Another song by Crispin, followed by socializing.

23:50 Group sings "Hiyo" song. Women and men sing in turns with cheering.
