BACK to the cabin...stood there a long time. It was charred on the inside. Finally torn down. Two other children in the fire were not burned, but they died soon after from smoke inhalation (or that is what it was attributed to). Irene was the only survivor of that tragedy. And she bears terrible scars on her face and hands and body to show what a tragedy it was.
