15:00 The man is talking about an appointed governor of the Territory of Alaska, who was appointed by President Eisenhower in 1967 [?]. [Unclear talking.] 7 sons and 6 daughters, semi-retired in recent years [Unclear, laughter]. [Unclear talking about Territorial Governor.]

19:56 The speaker appears to change, but the recording remains unintelligible.

21:53 Piano music starts, accompanied by singing. [Unclear talking, break in the recording.]

24:57 [More unclear talking with periodic applause. Talking and unclear socializing.]
