A Michigander by birth Laurence McKinley Gould got a running start on a highly promising career by graduating magna cum laude from the University of Michigan, where he subsequently picked up a master's degree and a doctorate.

With such zest did he demonstrate his scientific competence that five years after graduation he was assistant director and geologist of the University of Michigan Greenland Expedition. The following year, 1927, he was assistant director and geographer of the Putnam Baffin Island Expedition, and he won more laurels as second in command and geologist-geographer of the Byrd Antarctic Expedition in 1928-30.

He hesitated along the way in 1931 to switch from a geology classroom at his alma mater to one at Carleton College, where during an 18-year tenure as president he added luster to this distinguished institution's name. Then, with emeritus added to president, he left Carleton for another geology classroom — now at the University of Arizona. American and foreign governments have honored him with medals and awards, leading scientific bodies have handed him presidencies along with assignments that would overburden an ordinary man. And he has not escaped a shower of honorary doctorates that numbered more than a score at last count.

Three years in the Arctic when Eskimo whalers were still hunting down the ocean mammals under sail, decades of conscientious study of Interior Alaska and its Native peoples, thousands of miles of arduous travel on snowshoes in search of his subject matter, together with assiduous historical research, have enabled him to produce notable series of paintings on the Yukon gold stampede and Alaska's history; and an unswerving determination to do an epic account on canvas of the "old life" of Eskimos and Indians.

M. C. Heurlin is unspoiled, dedicated, sometimes iconoclastic and never muted — "Red" to his schoolmates, "Rusty" to the unnumbered admirers of his art, and, he insists, "now 'Whitey' and soon to be 'Baldy'."

# Academic Dress

THE HISTORY OF ACADEMIC DRESS reaches far back into the early days of the oldest universities. It appears that academic clothing was first introduced and worn at Cambridge and Oxford Universities in England in the thirteenth century. Various modifications were soon introduced resulting in great diversity in color and style of cap, gown, and hood worn at different institutions.

The European custom was carried to America with the establishment of our own colleges and universities. In 1895, an academic code of dress was adopted and the standards accepted by most of the colleges and universities in the United States. Today the black cap, gown, and hood are generally worn. The following description explains dress worn at the University of Alaska:

**CAP** – The Oxford cap, the so-called mortarboard, is black and has a long tassel fastened to the middle of the top that is usually worn pendent over the left front of the cap. At many institutions colored tassels are worn to indicate the candidate's school or college. Here the black tassel is worn on the cap for all baccalaureate and master's degrees, and gold tassels are worn for all doctor's degrees.

**GOWN** – Three types of black gowns may be distinguished here in the academic procession. The baccalaureate gowns have long, pointed sleeves. The master's gowns have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away in the front. The doctor's gowns are faced with velvet and have bell-shaped sleeves with three bars of velvet.

**HOOD** – Here candidates for master's and doctor's degrees wear hoods with a velvet trim which indicate the degree the candidate has earned: Master of Arts, white; Master of Business Education, drab; Master of Education, light blue; Master of Engineering, orange; Master of Fine Arts, brown; Master of Science, yellow; and Doctor of Philosophy, dark blue. The lining of the hood in every case is blue and yellow, the colors of the University.

**GOLD CORD** – At the University of Alaska, graduating seniors with high scholastic standing are singled out for special recognition during commencement exercises. A gold cord is placed around the shoulder of each graduating senior with a 3.5 or higher cumulative grade point average (out of a possible 4.0). The President of the University presents the cords to the eligible graduates immediately after they receive their diplomas.
