- Food in special dishes - children's favorite dishes, cake, pie, cookies, cigarettes, snuff, whiskey, Indian foods - what children used to like & ask for

Clothing given - also colors children liked, kinds of clothes kids liked (fur)

People to give to selected by picking those who helped at the time.

Potlach food - Bear hunting was no luck - caught pike (frozen in cache) - to use for snow ice cream; moose, beavers - saved for potlach.

● Saved from fall - berries, always save best, ducks, geese
Save to give away

Potlach lasts Monday - Saturday; then Sunday night is clean up - wash-tub dance. Women come in with dish full of food (cookies, pie, cake, fish, frozen meat - small cut - bite at time) dressed in face mask, funny line up in front of canvas; drums - one guy at each end w/ stick & rabbit hide to keep time with singers. All women sing. Women leave ~~then~~ Men come in and sing. All go to store buy whatever they can - coke, candy.

● Do it all again. Boys dressed in funny clothes like Halloween - boys come in and sing too
