I am a graduate student at the University of Alaska Fairbanks. I am working with the Barrow Dancers as a part of my graduate study until 2004 when I finish my graduate study. This project is funded by the Ruth Croxton Memorial Fellowship and Geist Fund of the University of Alaska Museum. By interviewing you, I would like to learn why Inupiaq people dance, how Inupiaq dances show Inupiaq identities, and what traditional dances mean to the Inupiaq people.

You do not have to participate in this research if you do not want to. You may discontinue involvement in this project at any time. My focus is to use the data that I collect to learn about Inupiaq dances and their Inupiaq identities through various generations. A fee of \$25.00/ hour, which North Slope Borough establishes as hourly rate, is being paid for your participation. I would like to record with an audio tape recorder while interviewing you. I will only record if I have your permission. The original copies of the audio recordings will be kept in my possession during the project. With your permission, the audio recordings will be deposited in the Inupiat History, Language, and Culture Commission of the North Slope Borough and at Oral History Program at the University of Alaska Fairbanks. You will choose where the tape can be preserved. If you desire, I would like to offer a copy of the interview tape to you.


I will acknowledge you for information you have given me that you want to be public information. Again, you may change your mind if you are not comfortable to participate in this project. If you would like to participate, please sign below.


