If you ever come into Canada - do come and visit us.

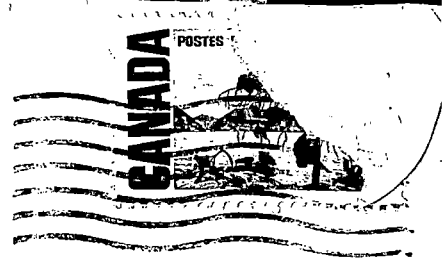
