

**Memo on Restrictions for H83-337 and H83-338 (now H 2002-13-08)**

As per Robert Drozda, the tapes H83-338 (currently accessioned as H 2002-13-08) and H83-337 were actually part of the ANCSA 14 (H) (1) tapes and are subject to the restrictions (or lack thereof) on the other ANCSA tapes. One-third of the ANCSA tapes were initially deposited with the UAF OH Program which is why they have an OH call number. Other two-thirds of collection in Anchorage. Collection now reunited, Drozda has full set of copies which he will be turning over to us later this fall.

Craig Mishler was engaged to create a transcript of H83-337/338 and turn them over to the BIA. He created the transcripts, but did not turn them over. Mishler references both of these tapes in his book, Neerihinjik: We Traveled From Place to Place: the Gwich'in Stories of Johnny and Sarah Frank. Mishler later transferred the set of recordings, including these BIA/ANCSA tapes, to the UAF OH Program where it was accessioned as the Johnny and Sarah Frank Collection.

According to Robert Drozda, although Johnny and Sarah did not sign an actual paper agreement, they were both paid for their information they gave to the original interviewers thus transferring the copyright to the federal government (namely the Bureau of Indian Affairs). These tapes were also collected with public monies making them available to the public.

H83-337 is actually the second part of this interview (it was accessioned improperly). It is not currently in the collection since Drozda has it at the time of this writing. H83-338 was reaccessioned as H 2002-13-08 and is currently linked to the Johnny and Sarah Frank collection series record.

When the ANCSA tapes arrive, these two tapes should be reaccessioned, linked to their ANCSA series record, and cross-referenced to the Johnny and Sarah Frank collection.
