Enclosed are eight audiotapes, containing the following interviews:

Interview with Gerald Clark, 4/29/94, talking about his Alaska archaeology career (two tapes);

Interview with Nels Evens, 4/20/94, talking about Petersburg, Alaska, local history;

Interview with Andrew L. Mathisen, 4/23/94, talking about Petersburg, Alaska, local history;

Interview with John Mattson, 5/4/94, talking about Chugach Forest archaeology (two tapes);

Interview with Linda Finn Yarborough, 5/3/94, talking about her Alaska archaeology career (two tapes).

Note that Mattson and Yarborough, citing directions from their USDA Forest Service superiors, declined to authorize rights to UAF Archives, and instead gave them to the National Archives. USDA Forest Service Region 10 archaeologist Gerald Clark, citing directions from his superiors, did authorize rights to UAF Archives. Consequently, I am sending you (as per their direction) copies of the Mattson and Yarborough tapes (with the originals going to National Archives), because I wish to keep UAF Archives as the master repository for an audio library of Alaska archaeology history.

Signed UAF release forms are enclosed for the other four tapes.

I would like to reiterate my request for a play-back of the HTRL numbers assigned to the tapes I've been sending up. In addition to the enclosed, I've sent you interview tapes of Frederica de Laguna, James Van Stone, Chuck Deters, Ron Kent, Doug Reger, Michael R. Yarborough, Terenty Mercurief, Andronik Kashevarof, John Enge, Eldor Lee, Geraldine Frink, and Dean Weeden.
