I am embarrassed to say I have just found the letter from our office to you, requesting permission to let our patrons have access to the Dorothy I. Clifton tape that Hetty Ruth Lindburg recorded.

In regards to the letter of April 12th please disregard the reference to the content of the tape in question. However, the other information is still relevant. We do not require full release of ownership of the tape, just permission to be able to let our patrons have access to the tape for their use. You may place restrictions as to the tapes access, such as no broadcasting or use for profit, to be notified of patron usage, etc.

If this sounds acceptable to you, consider this as our acknowledgment of the right to access the tape, not to have ownership thereof. For our records we will still need your permission in writing. You may either sign the enclosed release form and write in restrictions at the bottom, or send us your own release.
