Rasmusen Library Archives, Fairbanks, Alaska. These tapes will be available for future researchers. If you wish I will send you copies of the recordings.
- 3) Participation in this study is voluntary and you may discontinue participation at any time.
- 4) I will use information I collect to the best of my understanding. I will try to check my conclusions with you, but will acknowledge that any mistakes I make will be mine.


